Mercyhurst University in Erie, PA, invites applications for the position of Assistant Professor of Intelligence Studies in the School of Intelligence, Computing & Global Politics. The position is at the Erie campus and begins Fall Semester 2024.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Successful candidates will teach introductory and applied courses in Crime & Law Enforcement intelligence analysis at the undergraduate and graduate levels, in addition to the ability to teach undergraduate or graduate courses in areas:

- Leadership in Intelligence
- Advanced Analytic Techniques
- Intelligence Collection and Analysis

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

To be hired at the tenure-track assistant professor level, applicants should possess a Ph.D., other terminal degree, and/or significant experience in a discipline related to intelligence studies. Candidates should have five years of IC experience with special attention given to applicants who have ten or more years of practitioner experience and the ability to manage applied analytic projects.

SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Expertise in Analyst Notebook is highly desired. In addition to instruction, duties will include curriculum development, service to the profession, and participation in University and Intelligence Studies activities, including student mentoring, development of internship and employment opportunities, and grants. The selected candidate must demonstrate a commitment to teaching excellence, continued learning in their field, academic scholarship, and public scholarship.

Full-time faculty are expected to be on campus Monday through Friday, with a minimum of six office hours available.
