The Psychology Department at Mercyhurst College (www.mercyhurst.edu) invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professorship to begin Fall 2012. Candidates are sought with a strong background in biological psychology/behavioral-cognitive neuroscience.

Requirements: (1) doctorate in psychology, (2) commitment to excellence in teaching, and (3) research promise/accomplishment.

Duties include undergraduate teaching, advising and mentoring students, and research. Teaching responsibilities will include courses in biological psychology, research methods and statistics, and introductory psychology. Typical teaching load is 8 courses per year.

In addition, the ideal candidate would have an active research profile, be open to applying for extramural funding, and be interested in developing an undergraduate research program in biological psychology.
