

Chief Information Officer

Mercyhurst University seeks a Chief Information Officer to lead the University's technological advancement as defined by the 2020 Strategic Plan.

The CIO will be responsible for managing a department of 15 IT professionals who provide technology services for 3 campuses. The CIO will develop and manage a university-wide plan for technology and will develop related policies and practices. The CIO will chair the Information Technology Steering Committee to regularly review the university's progress toward the strategic goals. Together with the Director of Libraries, the CIO will coordinate efforts to provide robust academic resources to support existing academic programs, enabling them to flourish. The CIO will represent Mercyhurst to Educause, the Association of Independent Colleges and Universities, the Sloan Consortium, and the Consortium for Computing in Undergraduate Education.

A Masters Degree is required; a Doctorate is preferred. The qualified candidate will have a minimum of ten years direct experience managing information services in a college/university environment, including budgeting, planning and staff/personnel development and evaluation. Knowledge of network administration, computer support, Helpdesk administration, database administration, Datatel administrative software, web design, PCI compliance, information security management and server management are a plus. Knowledge and experience integrating the use of technology in pedagogical design, curriculum development and online instruction are preferred. The position will report jointly to the Vice President of Academic Affairs and the Chief Financial Officer and will be a member of the President's Staff.

The position is available June 1, 2012 and compensation is competitive. The application deadline is March 2, 2012.
