



Executive Director of Wellness

An Executive Director is sought to lead the campus counseling center and student health center at Mercyhurst College.

The long-range goal for the Executive Director is to develop an integrated, multi-departmental wellness program to holistically address the multi-faceted health needs of the students. The Executive Director serves on the leadership team of the Division of Student Life.

A doctorate in psychology or social work is required. Applicants will need a current Pennsylvania license permitting the candidate to provide direct clinical services to a small caseload and clinical supervision to staff and interns of the counseling center.

A minimum 5 years of management experience is required, along with clinical/administrative experience in medical settings. Experience in the development of multidisciplinary wellness and behavioral medicine programs is preferred. Grant writing experience is a plus.

Send cover letter, resume or vita, and names, titles, and contact information for three professional references with whom you have worked in the past 10 years.
