

## **TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION IN SPECIAL EDUCATION - MERCYHURST COLLEGE**

Mercyhurst College is seeking candidates for a tenure-track assistant professor position within the Department of Education beginning Fall 2010. Candidates should have a doctorate in special education or a related field at the time of appointment (ABD considered) and be committed to outstanding teaching and research.

The primary teaching responsibilities will include undergraduate courses focusing on children and youth with high incidence disabilities. The candidate is expected to develop partnerships, and work collaboratively with local school districts and community agencies; engage in research and scholarly activities; advise undergraduate students. Additionally, the candidate is expected to have experience in one or more of the following: direct instruction, applied behavior analysis, inclusive practices, and three years of work experience in educational settings.

Mercyhurst College is a Catholic liberal arts college that strongly values the teaching and research components of undergraduate and graduate education. The College is located in Erie, PA, a city on the shores of Lake Erie in northwest Pennsylvania.
