Qualified candidates will be hired as full-time, tenure-track assistant professors for the 2012-2013 academic year; however, this position is open for immediate hire during the 2011-2012 academic year with appointment as a part-time faculty member.

The ideal candidate is an individual with solid academic preparation, professional experience, an understanding of national and global business issues, and a true passion for helping students become successful, well-rounded business leaders.

The preferred academic and professional qualifications include a doctorate (or current candidate) in management, business administration, or a closely related business discipline. Candidates who are ABD with significant progress towards completion of a doctoral degree are encouraged to apply. This position also requires the ability to teach core business courses at the undergraduate level, including the Capstone Course in Business Policy and Strategy, prior teaching experience at the College /University level, demonstration of the ability to contribute towards the development of scholarship and research within the WSB, and experience in review of program and course outcomes. Private sector experience in leadership, entrepreneurship, management, and E-commerce is helpful.
