DEGREE PROGRAMS



Bachelor of Fine Arts

This degree is comprised of a rigorous curriculum in dance theories and techniques with performance and choreographic opportunities that build a pre-professional resumé.

Bachelor of Arts

This degree is grounded in the liberal arts and allows a student to complete a dual major, minor, and/or concentration complementary to the field or to complete accelerated programming.

Bachelor of Arts with Pedagogy Concentration

This area of study provides skills through additional curriculum and experiential learning that prepares the student for success in studio teaching.

Sports Medicine: Integrated Track

We prepare future health care professionals through experiential learning, hands-on patient interactions, and Sports Medicine-specific courses including injury evaluation and assessment, nutrition, health care administration, kinesiology, exercise physiology, and applicable research. Dance Club


Members of the student-sponsored Dance Club promote and provide opportunities for leadership, service, departmental support, social activities, and community outreach.
