



The Master of Science in Secondary Education: Pedagogy and Practice program is a **one-year, online** program offering graduate-level coursework for someone who is looking to earn a secondary education teaching certification from the Pennsylvania Department of Education. This online program focuses on the pedagogical links of teaching as art, science and social justice, while incorporating theory, research and practice. Coursework will be offered in educational research, foundations, learner diversity, cross-curricular best assessment and teaching practices. An additional course with content-specific teaching methodologies in English, math, science, or social studies is required for those seeking their secondary education teaching certification.
