The successful applicant will support the Mercy mission and the Department of Physician Assistant Studies' mission, vision, and goals.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Adjunct instructors may be responsible for teaching a section of a course or a specific unit within a course. Adjunct instructors are responsible for engaging in student assessment/evaluation activities and providing students with feedback and support throughout the course. Adjunct instructors may teach in multiple courses offered in the graduate physician assistant program.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Graduation with a Master's degree (minimum) from an accredited physician assistant program
- Current NCCPA certification
- Experience in physician assistant or medical education preferred
- Experience as a practicing physician assistant preferred
- Excels in networking and demonstrates professional communication both oral and written
- Candidate must be currently eligible to work in the United States. Hiring is contingent on successful background check and required clearances.
