JOB DESCRIPTION

Mercyhurst University in Erie, PA, invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track position of **Assistant Professor of Computer Science** in the Department of Computing and Information Sciences (CIS) of the Ridge College of Intelligence Studies and Applied Sciences, to begin in the 2022 Spring or 2022 Fall Semester. Applicants should possess a Ph.D. in Computer Science. ABD candidates are encouraged to apply. Candidates will also be considered for individuals who possess a master's degree and significant practitioner experience; however, hiring will be at an instructor level.

Candidates should be prepared to teach introductory and advanced courses in computer science at the undergraduate and graduate levels, in support of the cyber security and data science programs. In addition to teaching excellence, faculty are expected to engage in scholarly activity and participate in service to the community and institution.

Mercyhurst University is a fully accredited, comprehensive institution, in 1926 by the Sisters of Mercy. Located in northwestern Pennsylvania along Lake Erie, the university is home to more than 3,000 undergraduate and graduate students, offering over 50 majors and 70 concentrations.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Candidates are also to arrange for submission of three letters of recommendation to the same email address. Only electronic applications will be accepted. Review of applications will begin on immediately and continue until the position is filled.
