POLICY:	Mercyhurst University policy prohibits sexual harassment against any staff members, applicant, student, administrator, faculty member, or third-party vendor. Respect for the dignity and work of each individual is a guideline of the University. All persons will be held to standards of conduct which ensure that all members of the University community are free from sexual and other forms of harassment. Nothing in the policy is meant to limit the rights of an aggrieved person to seek relief in a state or federal court of law. The term harassment refers to unwelcome mistreatment based upon a person's protected characteristics or class membership which is intended to or has the effect of preventing or interfering with a person's full participation in the University's work or academic environment.
