Mercyhurst University in Erie, Pennsylvania is accepting applications for a full-time non-tenure track position at the rank of instructor in the area of Sport Business Management to begin Fall of 2022. This position requires a master's degree in Sport Business, an MBA or other related field with a preference for individuals with experience in sport business and/or facilities, event, or hospitality management. A terminal degree is desirable.

Successful candidates will be creative and enthusiastic individuals with a commitment to quality education, student centeredness, and being part of a collaborative team within the Walker College of Business.

Candidates are expected to actively participate in departmental, college and university-wide committee work; curriculum development; academic support services such as undergraduate advisement; student recruitment; and professional organizations.
