- Maintain high, mid, and low fidelity simulation equipment and collaborate faculty education from simulation and clinical partners.
- Identify opportunities to secure additional resources via foundation, government, and other grant programs that will enhance the simulation experiences.
- Engage in professional development that includes simulation curricula that benefits the nursing department and students.
- Collaborates with nursing faculty, Program Directors, the Zurn College of Natural and Health Sciences Dean, and the Office for Institutional Effectiveness to establish a strategic plan with short- and long-range strategic goals for simulation.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current, unencumbered Pennsylvania State Registered Nurse license
- Master's degree in Nursing
- Current clearances, certifications, and health requirements
- Experience using healthcare simulation methods

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Doctoral degree from a regionally accredited institution with a focus in Nursing or closely related profession or current enrollment with completion within 3 years
- Expertise in the nursing discipline as recognized at the regional, national, or international level; preferred Certified Nurse Educator (CNE) and/or Certified Healthcare Simulation Educator (CHSE)
- Prior classroom, clinical, or simulation instruction experience at the university level
- Experience supervising university faculty, staff, and students to plan, organize, direct, and evaluate performance.
- Evidence of sustained scholarly productivity as indicated by publications, grants, continuing education, and presentations.
- Evidence of community contributions as indicated by volunteer opportunities, partnerships, and projects.
