POSITION SUMMARY

Under the general supervision of the Head Baseball Coach, the Assistant Baseball Coach will provide support and assistance with all aspects of the intercollegiate baseball program. The Assistant Baseball Coach will work to provide optimal playing conditions for Mercyhurst University baseball athletes which will include activities such as the supervision of the maintenance of the baseball field and the maintenance and security of all baseball related equipment and supplies. - Works with Admissions and Financial Aid to expedite the registration, admission, and other administrative processing of all student athletes.
- Responsible for securing support staff including security, officials, and concession workers for all home games.
- Responsible for the maintenance of the playing surfaces of the baseball field and the supervision of student workers to assist in this process.
- Under the direction of the Head Baseball Coach, the Assistant Baseball Coach is assigned to work with selected athletes on various game day situations.
- Works with the Head Baseball Coach in developing line-ups, game strategies, and individual work-out and practice needs for various student athletes.
