The position starts in the Spring 2020 semester (January 2020). Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Cybersecurity, Computer Science, Computer Engineering or a related area (ABDs will be considered). Preference will be given to candidates with research and teaching interests in cybersecurity and experience in online teaching environments.

We are looking for a passionate teacher with the ability to work effectively with others in a collegial environment dedicated to student learning. Our department is experiencing major growth. In Fall 2018, we successfully added two new graduate programs: Master of Science in Cybersecurity and Master of Science in Cyber Risk Management to our existing Master of Science in Data Science program.

In addition to the cyber security courses, there may also be opportunities to teach data science courses as well as general computer science courses both on-campus as well as online offerings.
