

# Degree Requirements

**MS Applied Intelligence | Online | 2016-2017**

All MS Applied Intelligence students must complete a minimum of 34 or 36 credits (depends on whether a student intends to complete the thesis or research-based projection option) in degree requirements to qualify for graduation. A minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA is required for graduation. No course grade below C is awarded graduate credit. Nor will any student be allowed to earn credit toward degree requirements for more than a total of two graduate courses in which a C grade has been earned. Students who receive two Cs or one F may be dismissed from the program.
