

Visiting Instructor of Spanish

Mercyhurst University department of World Languages and Cultures is seeking a visiting full-time Instructor of Spanish for the 2019-2020 academic year. Teaching responsibilities include instruction in Spanish language and Hispanic cultures. Other responsibilities would include participation in department meetings, and general assistance as needed with the Spanish program. This is a one-year position with duties beginning in late August 2019.

The candidate should demonstrate evidence of excellence in teaching. Native or near-native ability in both Spanish and English is essential. Experience in linguistics, especially the field of sociolinguistics, is highly desirable. Candidates who already have the Ph.D. are preferred but ABD will be considered.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Candidates should submit letter of application, C.V., statement of teaching philosophy, and three letters of recommendation, at least one of which should clearly address teaching ability to:
